PEKING - VERY RARE INGOING JAPAN/CHINA COMBINATION COVER WITH CHINA 3ca & JAPAN 3-COLOUR FRANKING; Remarkable and attractive 18 Oct. 1896 env. to "I. CUSTOMS, PEKING, CHINA" (printed address; opened out for display with tiny fault at top) routed "Per [Yokohama Maru s/s" and franked by Japan Koban 5s Blue + 2s Red (2) + 1s Green all tied by mostly fine "YOKOHAMA/JAPAN" c.d.s.'s, but additionally franked alongside by a China 1894 Dowager Empress 3ca Orange-yellow tied by a partly fine blue oval Chinese Shanghai 'Seal' mark, having partly fine blue 2-ring "CUSTOMS" c.d.s.'s of Shanghai (20 Oct.) and Peking (26 Oct.) on the reverse. It is believed that only one other such ingoing Combination Cover from Japan has been recorded. Important Exhibition Item. PHOTO – BACK COVER
